WHAT'S THE CAUSE??

Changing the lives of children and adults with special needs, one puppy at a time. Project 2 Heal's goal is to utilize the healing power of dogs to help children and adults with special needs and Veterans who were wounded or disabled. People have contacted Project 2 Heal for service dogs thinking the Waxhaw non-profit was a service dog provider. The reality is that they donate puppies to service organizations where specialized training is provided. There's a big difference between a service dog (which is ultimately obtained through the organizations P2H donates dogs to) and a skilled companion dog that is trained to do basic commands.

A Service Dog:

- -Guides people who are blind or have low vision, retrieving dropped objects for them
- -Alerts people who are deaf or hard of hearing to sounds and the presence of others
- -Carries and picks up items, opens doors, or flips switches for people with disabilities who have limited use of hands or arms, limited use of their legs, or limited ability to bend or stoop -Pulls wheelchairs
- -Alerts people with disabilities to the onset of seizures, protects and cushions them if they fall, revives them, and performs other tasks that reduce the risk of seizure-related injury
- -Provides physical support and assists people with physical disabilities with stability and balance

A Companion or Emotional Support Dog:

- -Provides companionship to therapeutically benefit the life of a person with a disability or special need
- -Usually has a basic skill level; not all dogs in this category are utilized in public
- -Can be a dog for children with disabilities, utilized as a parenting tool for the therapeutic benefit to the child
- -Assists people with mental or emotional disabilities who use the assistance of this type of animal to function independently

A skilled companion dog is well trained, but does not have public access. This is what a majority of the special needs children require. They do not need a service dog, but rather a well-trained companion.

Portions of P2H dogs go through emotional support dog training at the service dog organizations where they have been donated and are placed by those organizations with individuals in need. These dogs are exceptional dogs for depression and serve as wonderful companions.
